Things to Prepare Before Coming to China



1.Visa

How to Apply for Visa to China?

• Please bring your valid passport, a copy of Admission Notice from BNU and "Visa Application for Study in China" (JW202/201) form to apply for X1/X2 Visa at Chinese Consulate/Embassy in your home country.

• Please consult the Embassy to check whether the "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" is necessary for your visa application.

• Please get the original copies of the Admission Notice and JW 202/201 form back from the embassy. These documents are necessary for visa extension upon your arrival in Beijing.

Type of Visa to Apply for:

Please apply for X1/X2 student visa before coming to China. According to Chinese immigration laws, students with visa-free access and tourist visa cannot be changed to valid student visa within mainland China.

Important visa notice:

• Please arrive in China after August 20, 2019, to avoid any visa expiration issues.

• According to Chinese law and regulations, students with X1 Visa are required to apply for Residence Permit within 30 days of their arrival to China. You will be fined heavily if you fail to do so. You are required to register at the International Students Office first before applying for Residence Permit. If you arrive before the registration date and face any issues with your visa, please contact ISO immediately.

2. Accommodation

On campus Dormitory

There are 7 international student dorms in BNU. For students who want to live on campus, please apply for accommodation online after you' ve received the Admission Notice.

For more information about accommodation, please visit http://iso. bnu.edu.cn.

Deadline for Dorm Reservation

Once you' ve received the admission notice, please log in to http://apply.bnu.edu.cn to apply. Application opens from 9:00 am May 28, 2019 to 12:00 am July 31, 2019.

Due to the limited rooms available, please make your reservations quickly. Application will be closed after the deadline.

Note: Chinese Government (CSC) and Confucius (excluding Confucius Study Plan) scholarship recipients, as well as exchange students who have their accommodation fee waived, are not required to reserve online. Your housing arrangements will be settled by the school.

How to apply?

After confirming your application status online, log in to the application website http://apply.bnu.edu.cn and apply.

Living off campus

You can choose to live off campus. For more information about renting rooms or apartments in Beijing, please consult local rental agents. We strongly advise you to read the contract carefully before signing, in case of any fraud. After your check-in, please apply the "Temporary Residence Form" in time. You can only check in at on campus dorms 7 days before registration, if you arrive Beijing earlier than that, we advise you to book a hotel near school in advance.



3. Physical Examination

Is physical examination necessary?

It is not required for students who are studying in China for just one semester.

Students who are studying in China for one academic year or more must do the physical examination and obtain medical certificate. Those who already have a residence permit need not to go through the medical checkup again. However, if the student is under the age of 18, then then he/she has to undergo medical checkup again.

Requirements of Foreigner Physical Examination Form

- Original copy
- Valid for 6 months
- Official stamp stamped on top of the passport photo
- Signed and stamped by issuing doctor (last page)
- If you have to photocopy the blank form, please do it double sided and NOT two pages
 - Original copy of AIDS, Syphilis, EGC and X-Ray test reports



4. Currency Exchange

Do I need RMB cash?

Please change some RMB cash before coming to Beijing or bring 1 to 2 international credit card that works in China. You are advised to have at least 10000 RMB (for visa, physical examination, living expenses, accommodation, food and transportation). Please be extra careful when you are carrying around cash.

Can I pay by international bank cards?

Tuition fees can only be paid in RMB using debit card with Union Pay logo issued in China. If you are carrying foreign currencies, please change to RMB, open a bank account and apply for a debit card immediately before paying tuition fees.





5. Insurance



Based on Article 40, Order 42 "Regulations on School Recruitment and training of International Students", the school implements insurance system to all international students. As requested by relevant national regulations and school requirements, during the registration international students must purchase group insurance for international students studying in China provided by Ping' an Insurance. Any other kinds of insurance cannot be accepted for enrollment. Students who do not insured or the ones whose insurances do not meet the requirement cannot enroll.

Can I Purchase Insurance before registration?

You could buy the insurance for international students offered by China Ping' an Company online.

Purchasing time from January July 1 to August 30, 2019.

Please refer to http://www/lxbx.net for more info.

You may log in to buy the insurance for 6 months or 12 months. The insurance period should be consistent with your visa period. Please refer http://iso.bnu.edu.cn/en/pages?cid=370&pid=183 for instruction of payment.

Please save the payment record and show us when you register.

Ping' an Company reserves the final right to interpret the terms and conditions of the insurance.

Note: Scholarships students with insurance covered are not required to purchase insurance.





6. Documents required

- Valid passport & Visa
- Original copy of Admission Notice
- Visa Application for Study in China (JW202/201) Form
- 2 inch passport photo (at least 3 pieces)
- Physical Examination and Blood Test Report (original copy) (if applicable)
- Tuition Fees (Debit bank card with Union Pay issued in China)

• Original copy of graduation certificate (for students who are already studying in China)

• Payment record of group insurance

• For undergraduate and graduate students who only provided Expected Graduation Certificate, please provide your Certificate of graduation and Degree Certificate (only applied to the graduate freshman).

Note: Students are advised to have extra copies of important documents, in the event that they go missing.

7. Packing your luggage

Beijing has four distinct seasons. Depending on your length of stay in China, you are advised to bring clothes suitable for the different weather conditions. Some toiletries and other necessities would be useful too, for the first few days before you are fully settled.

8. Apply for Muslim Canteen Card

If you would like to apply for Muslim Canteen Card, please go to International Students Office to fill in a Muslim Canteen application form with your campus card before September 6. After you submit the application, you cannot withdraw it. Please be noticed that you need pay the management fee of 15% while dinning at all other campus canteens. Things to Prepare After Arrival in Beijing



1. Getting to BNU from Airport

BNU Airport Pickup Service

BNU offers free pickup service for students from the airport between 8am and 8pm, August 26 to 28, 2019 (GMT+8). The pickup location is Beijing International Airport T3 Arrival Hall. Please lookout for people

holding the sign (refer to picture below). Please have your Admission Notice ready for verification.

Taxi

You can also take a taxi to BNU. It should cost around 120RMB. Please remember to take the receipt before getting off.



Airport Bus

You may also take the airport bus to BNU. Tickets can be purchased at the shuttle bus booth located outside Terminal 2 and Terminal 3. Please get off at Bei Tai Ping Zhuang stop and walk 10-15 minutes to BNU.

Airport Express

You can take airport express from T2 (06 : 35-23 : 10) or T3 (06 : 20-22 : 50). Please get off at DongZhiMen Station and change to Line 2, then get off at JiShuiTan Station. You can walk, take taxi or bus from there to BNU (1.5 kilo from the stop to campus).

After arriving in Beijing, please check in to your reserved dormitory, rented house or reserved hotel. Please be reminded that you need to get the Temporary Residence Form within 24 hours of checking in.

2. Accommodation

Checking in to campus dormitory

Students who have reserved a dorm room on campus, can check in at the reception with your Admission Notice, between August 26 and August 29, 2019. If you are arriving before August 26, 2019 please contact the reception or arrange your own accommodation. If you are arriving after August 29, please contact the reception to check if they can keep your reservation.

Notice for students living on campus:

• Accommodation fee and key deposit (100/200rmb, differs in dorms) are required to be paid in full within two weeks of checking in. Students can only pay these by cash.

• Feel free to change dorm rooms (subjected to availability) within two weeks after the end of registration (August 31 to September 13). Two weeks of rent would be non-refundable if you check out or change rooms.

Temporary Residence Form for students living off campus

Students living in hotels or hostels off campus should contact the reception there for Temporary Residence Form.

Students living in rented apartments should go to the police station with your landlord within 24hrs of check-in, to obtain the Temporary Residence Form. Landlords should bring along their local registered residence, housing certificate, rent contract and ID. International students need bring their passports.

Notice for students living off campus:

• A copy of the Temporary Residence Form and Chinese contact number are required for registration

and visa processing.

 Please restrain from your address while your visa application being processed.

 Please get an updated copy of the Temporary Residence Form from the reception or local police office, within 24hrs of getting your new visa or you will be fined.

3. Bank Account & Money Exchange

Documents required to apply for bankcard

Valid passport, Admission Notice, Student card/booklet and Registration Form of Temporary Residence.

Bank Branches

You can apply for a Union Pay debit card at Bank of China (WenHuiYuan Branch) for free.

You can also apply for Union Pay debit card at any other bank. For scholarship and exchange students who receive allowance per month, you could only apply a debit card from Bank of China.

Application process

1)Fill in the application form《个人账户开户及综合服务申请表》(refer to picture).

All other online and e-banking services can be applied concurrently. (Present your admission notice to get 1 year of card fee waive)

2)Collect the receipt 《客户回单》.

Do make sure that you take the receipt《客户回单》(refer to picture), from the counter and keep it.《客户回单》should include three information: passport name, passport number and bankcard number.

Note: Scholarship students are required to submit Customer Receipt《客户回单》 to ISO, to receive your monthly allowance.

Type of bank card

Please apply for a Union Pay debit card associated with your bank account. Union Pay is widely used in China, it has the same functions as



all other debit cards and remittance can be received directly via the card.

Can I register first before applying for bankcard?

We strongly encourage you to open your bank account before registration. Visa application may take up to 30 days and you would not have you passport during that period. Banks would not be able to process any application without your original passport. As such, you are advised to get a bankcard before registration.

Money exchange

Students are advised to have sufficient amount of RMB in cash ready to pay for rent, visa and other fees.

Note: Banks do not do money exchange on weekends. If you happen to arrive during the weekends and do not have any RMB, please change some at the airport.

The application of bankcard and receiving for monthly allowance both need time, so the scholarship students should prepare at least 10,000RMB to cover the living fee of three months.

4. Registration

X Important Notice:

All international students are required to register at ISO during the designated registration period, at the beginning of every semester, regardless of visa status. Students who are unable to register on time due to specific reasons must submit a formal paper application to ISO at least one week in advance; otherwise he/she will be regarded as quitting from BNU automatically.

Documents required for registration:

1)Valid passport

2) Original copy of Admission Notice with signature

3) JW202/201 Visa Application for Study in China with signature

4) Original copy of Temporary Residence Form

5) 2 passport-sized photos (white background, student ID written at the back)

6) Tuition fees (paid by debit card with Union Pay issued in China)

7) Visa fees (you are advised to prepare 1,000RMB in cash, as fees differ according to the type of visa)

8) Payment record of group insurance for international students.


9) Original copy of Physical Examination Report:

For students holding X1 Visa who has already done their physical examination, you are required to present all documents for verification, which includes: Foreigner Physical Examination Form, AIDS, Syphilis, ECG and X-Ray test results and 60 RMB (in cash) for verification of report.

10) For undergraduate and graduate students who only provided Expected Graduation Certificate, please provide your Certificate of graduation and Degree Certificate (only applied to the graduate freshman).

7. Campus Card

8. Physical Examination/ Verification

Do I need go through physical examination again if I' ve already done it at home?

If you did the physical examination outside of China, it needs to be verified. Please go to Haidian Clinic of Beijing International Travel Healthcare Center for verification.

What if the report is disapproved?

In the event that your report is disapproved, please contact Haidian Clinic of Beijing International Travel Healthcare Center for more information regarding reexamination.

Physical examination arranged by ISO

For those who do not have physical examination, or the examination form is disapproved, please arrive at the hall of No.3 International Students Apartment at 12:30 pm on August 30, 2019 to take the examination arranged by ISO. (Notice: Greasy food is not applicable that day.)

Students can collect their report at ISO two weeks after the date of examination.

The actual date and time of physical examination arranged by ISO may not line up with your visa application, hence students are advised to go by themselves and get it done earlier.

Only Chinese Language students from College of Chinese Language and Culture are required to take the placement test.

Test contents and time

Written and oral test. For Chinese language students, placement tests will take place on August 29, 2019.


Note:





